ADF is one of the nation's most respected and successful United States **Supreme Court advocates**. They have played various roles in 74 Supreme Court victories. Since 2011, ADF has represented parties in 15 victories at the Supreme Court. These victories have been on behalf of pastors, churches, religious organizations, college students, family-owned businesses, pro-life pregnancy centers, and many others. Many would be familiar with names like Jack Phillips, the cake baker from Denver or Barronelle Stutzman, the florist from Washington that ADF defended.

ADF was launched in 1994 by 35 Christian leaders like Alan Sears, Bill Bright, James Dobson, Larry Burkett, and Dr. D. James Kennedy to counter the legal efforts of the ACLU and other progressives. These leaders wanted to create an alliance-building legal organization with the goal of keeping the doors open for the Gospel.
