



Charles Darwin


- His theory gives a plausible mechanism to atheistic naturalism

- Falsely claimed that the young girls she studied on the island of Ta'u were far more sexually adventurous than Westerners, and much happier.






Wilhelm Reich

Alfred Kinsey

- Sexual pervert, Author of the books *Sexual Behavior in the Human Male* and *Sexual Behavior in the Human Female*

- Hefner took Kinsey's supposed data and sold the subjugation and exploitation of women as a sophisticated lifestyle choice.




John Money

Paul Elrich

- Published *The Population Bomb* in 1968
- The fear of overpopulation provided the motivation for atrocities and injustices around the world for the last 50 years.
- Based on completely debunked Malthusian sociological and agricultural theories

Helen Gurley Brown

- Author of *Sex and the Single Girl* and editor of *Cosmopolitan*
 - Her explicit goal was to encourage women to be sexual objects for men
- A professional propagandist who instructed her staff to make up stories to support the agenda. The “Cosmo Girl” was a complete sham.
